Accommodation

Tallinn has a great range of hotels to choose from. The host recommends the following:

1. [Tallink Spa & Conference Hotel](#) (around 100 euros/night)

Sadama 11A, 10111 Tallinn

The hotel is located near the port and the Old Town. It takes around 40 minutes to travel to the workshop venue at the University by public transportation.

2. [Park Inn by Radisson Meriton Conference & Spa Hotel Tallinn](#) (around 80 euros/night)

The hotel is in the corner of the Old Town. It takes around 30 minutes to travel to the meeting venue at the University by public transportation.

3. [Campus House by Larsen](#) (around 40 euros/night)

Akadeemia tee 32b, Tallinn

Within a few minutes from the University.

Travel information

From Airport to the City

Tram no. 4 conveniently takes you from the Airport to the city centre. Tickets for single trips (€2) can be purchased by tapping a contactless bank card against the validator by the front door of the vehicle (please check for the contactless payment sign) or alternatively by purchasing a QR ticket [here](#).

From the City to the University

Getting from the City to the University, the easiest and quickest way is to take a Bolt or CityBee taxi.

Alternatively, you can take public transportation. The trolley bus no. 3 and bus no. 11 take you directly to the meeting venue. From the port area (Tallinn Spa Hotel), you need to first take tram no 6 and then switch to either of the two aforementioned buses.
